Location of Claims:

Near the Nevada Scheelite Mill on the border of Churchill and Mineral Counties in Nevada. Area is Southeast of Fallon. (See map attached).

History:

These are undeveloped claims and they are in need of a drilling program. The owner reports assays of gold 5 oz. per ton, silver 67 oz. per ton and copper 6%. These minerals come in separate stringers with a $\frac{1}{4}$ mile of each other. They seem to develop in a fault area and the geology is not known.

The claims are near the oiled highway and electricity is within a mile distance. No water is in the immediate area. The country is flat to rolling.

Price and Terms:

Open - however, the owner would like to get \$1,000.00 per claim.

Dale Baer lives on the property in a shack and he will show you over the property.

The Fairview claims, Group 20, are several miles Northeast of the Morehouse claims.

Report:
