DEVELOPMENT: A prospect pit dug by hand.ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: The unmarked prospect is above Snow Creek about 1/3 of a mile north of the spring in section 35. The quartz crops out of Qal about 200 yards below the contact of the sediments and the granodiorite. The outcrop has been clobbered by hand. The quartz has clots and rosettes of moly within it as well as pyrite and chalcopyrite with minor copper oxides.

The Snow Creek uranium drill-sites are 1/2 mile to the southeast. It is the road to the drill sites that provide the best access to the prospect but the road is washed out near the mouth of the canyon.
