DEVELOPMENT: Two adits on the NE side of the ridge. A small mill and concentrator were present but are no longer operatable.ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: The mine workings are in a steel gray phyllite on the northeast side of a steep ridge. The workings follow iron stained, brecciated vein systems with highly irregular dips and strikes. They are relatively small with very room to develop without dropping below the ridge. Mineralization included; galena, copper and possible silver sulfides. Sample 2966.

A small prospect very near the crest of the ridge and possibly on the same vein system as the adits was sunk on a gossan-like quartz vein that was strongly oxidized and partially brecciated. Sample 2967
