GEOLOGY: Workings follow a N10-30W, near vertical shear zone in granodiorite. appears to be small lenses of silicated limestone along the zone. Some work has been done on a limestone-granodiorite contact zone to the west of the main shaft (Gabbs Exploration Shaft). The contact zone trends N60W, granodiorite to the northeast, marbleized limestone to the southwest. Northeast and northwesttrending lamprophyre dikes cut the granodiorite. Concentrations of pyrite occur in places along the limestone-granodiorite contact. The granodiorite ridge extending northwest from the main shaft and which contains most of the mine workings displays pervasive iron-staining. Scheelite occurs in sheared granodiorite along the zone, similiar to ore occurrences at the nearby Victory mine.
