GEOLOGY: A lenticular, N55W-trending, near-vertical, brecciated quartz vein formed along the contact between limestone and a lamprophyre dike. Vein fragments visible on the dump are 4'-5' thick, are brecciated with white quartz fragments in a matrix of sugary, Feox-stained quartz and carbonate. Clots of chalcopyrite, malachite, and chrysacolla occur in the vein material.

REMARKS: Mine workings appear to date from the 1920's-1930's, claim notice at foot of slope below the mine, Grandview Claim, is dated 1974, but no evidence of recent work was seen.
