

PRELIMINARY REPORT ON

ITEM 31 (238)

Name and Owner. GOLD KING GROUP, P. J. Brennen, Lodi via Luning, Nev.

Location and Holdings. 6 lode claims in Mammoth Mining District, Nye Co., Nevada. On north side Marble Canyon.

Accessibility and Transportation. By road 2½ E. of Lodi, last mile up steep gulch. Lodi 45 mi. N.E. of Luning, Nevada and about 85 mi. east of Fallon. Fair roads.

Geology. On the claims: limestones and volcanic rocks. Granitic intrusion about ¾ mi. to the south and east.

Veins or Ore Bodies. Two veins. One partly in the limestone and partly on the contact between the limestone and a light colored, altered porphyritic rock. The second one about 150 ft. south, and in the lime. Good grade ore occurs in bunches. It is silicious and oxidized, containing considerable iron oxide and shows some galena and lead carbonate. Unusual in that it contains considerably more gold than silver associated with lead in limestone.

Developement. One 250 ft. tunnel and a short one on each vein.

Present Equipment. None.

Metallurgy. "Smelting" ore.

Wood, Water and Power. Pinion timber and water close to property. Internal combustion engines for power as there is no available source of water or electric power.

Price and Terms. \$ 20,000.00, with time for development.

Possibilities.

Miscellaneous. Property was abandoned by original owners after doing the tunnel work. Located by present owner in 1913, who has driven several x-cuts in the lower tunnel on the "contact" vein.

Conclusions. Not recommended on account of the nature of the ore together with the high transportation charges to the smelters.
