DEVELOPMENT: Two shafts one approximately 100m deep, several dozer cuts, one DDH hole.ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: N10E near vertical tactite zone to 10m wide in limestone along, fault contact between Mule Springs limestone and Campito Fm. Fault shown as thrust by Albers and Stewart but it looks like high-angle normal fault. Tactite predominantly garnet with disseminated pyrite and chalcopyrite, large, oxidized. Some sulfide replacement of marble. Some activity in area within last few years. Estimated grade of zone + 1 percent Cu.
