Dorthy, Marjorie and May Claims

Name and Owner.

Locators Thomas Hayes & J. A. Reynolds. Mr Reynolds is the section foreman located at Klondike on the T. & G. Ry.

Location and Holdings.

Property held by location. Dorthy, Marjorie and a fractional claim called the May. In the South Lone Mt. District.

Accessibility and Transportation.

About 15 miles from Tonopah or 5 miles from McSweeney Sta. on T.&G.Ry, Wagon road of easy grade but rough.

Geology.

Limestone with quartz-porphry intrusions. Lime tilted to nearly vertical. Lime much altered. Formation eroded to low flat hills. Where ore occurs there is crushing between lime strata.

Veins or Ore Bodies.

Small bunches of surface ore as is usual in the Lone Mt. section, containing copper, silver, gold and lead. The Lillian prospect nearby shows considerable zinc. Sulphides of copper ~~and~~ lead and iron occur at the surface with the lead carbonate and silver chloride.

A few small surface cuts and holes.
