T H E L O N G S T R E E T M I N E

This property is located about fifty miles northeast from Tonopah, in Nye County, Nevada, on the east slope of the Monitor Range.

The ore occurs in silicified breccia, on the hanging wall of a contact between andesitic breccia and rhyolite-porphyry. This is probably a fault contact, as there is considerable gouge and fault material on the footwall. Away from the contact the breccia is very much altered.

The mineralized streak varies from .7' to 1.5' in width.

The accompanying map shows the development work, geology, location of samples, and the assay results.

The property was located about 1907, and all of the development work has been done by the present owner - J. Longstreet.

The price asked for the property is \$100,000.

Conclusions

The property is not recommended.
