CORY CANYON

Vanderburg
Ferguson (1937, p. 46) states that:

According to D. H. Donnelly of Hawthorne, molybdenite is present^{in granite} in Cory Canyon. In former years the deposit was prospected by several open-cuts. ~~A~~ Molybdenite occurs on ground included in the Naval Ammunition Depot at Hawthorne.

This deposit probably is in T. 7 N., R. 29 E. (see U. S. Geological Survey, Aurora and Powell Mtn. topographic quadrangle maps) in west-central Mineral County.
