Location: T. 35 N., R. 50 E., sections 10, 11, 13,14,15, 23, 24; T. 35 N., R. 51 E., sections 19, 30 Description: Newmont proposes to drill 865 holes, construct associated exploration roads and drill sites, and trench. These exploration activities would occur over a 3 year period beginning in 1996 and ending in 1999, The proposed activities would create a total of 255 acres of surface disturbance of which approximately 91 acres is proposed on public lands and 164 acres on private lands.

Type of Action: Plan of Operations

Location: T. 35 N., R. 50 E., sections 9, 16; T. 35 N., R. 51 E., section 32

Description: Newmont proposes to continue mining and expand the Lantern pit, the expansion of the North Lantern Waste Rock Disposal Facility, the construction of the South Lantern Waste Rock Disposal Facility, construction of associated haul roads, construction of a diversion ditch, and a 50 acre expansion of the North Area Leach Facility. The Lantern pit would not penetrate the water table, and consequently mine dewatering operations would not be required. The proposed mining activities would result in an additional 394 acres of disturbance of which 224 acres would occur on public lands and 170 acres would occur on private lands. A small portion of the T lazy S Allotment would be closed to grazing due to the proposed mining activity. A portion of the active permitted grazing use would be suspended until mining activity ceases and the closed area has been reclaimed.
