DEVELOPMENT: Lower working is caved adit striking N40E. Upper working is shaft. Drill or exploration road (about 5-10 yrs. old) extends from workings to east flank of range.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, location monuments still standing but appear old.

GEOLOGY: Sample 1549 collected from lower dump. Most of dump consists of black siliceous shale or cherty shale, some containing pyrite on fracture surfaces. However rock sampled consists of milky white, irregular shaped quartz veins & veinlets which cut the siliceous shales (cherts) & some limestones lithologies. Some of the veins are in a stockwork pattern & contain altered fragments of the host rock & possibly pyrite.
The adit portal begins in beige colored, slightly silicified limestone which forms thin to medium beds which strike N35W, 25SW. The GQ for this quad indicates this area is mapped as thermally metamorphosed Roberts Mtn. Fm.
