ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: N35E, 40NW breccia cutting quartzite and shale; Vein structure in hangingwall of breccia, N45W, 65NE dip, steeper structures roll into low-angle, some narrow(2") quartz veins cut fissile shale in the footwall of the breccia. The steeper structures occupied by parallel, brecciated, gossany quartz veins. All structures and veins are highly Feox-stained, MnO-staining/varnish on weathered outcrops. To the south of the sample site, outcrops of stockworks veining can be seen. The low-angle structure may be a thrust fault; at the portal of the adit, south of the sample site, narrow quartz veins occur along contorted bedding in shale; the veins are brecciated and are slightly offset across small faults. A low-angle structure cuts over the veins at the adit portal, the veins here contain hematite and wall rock fragments.
