ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None but assessment looks up to-date..posted

GEOLOGY: The large adit appears to be a cross-cut beneath a large NW trending vein exposed above the drainage adjacent to the road to Manhattan. The adit is posted and the entrance to the adit is locked closed.
The workings are hosted in argillitized shales and limestone of Ordovician age. Sample 2042 was chipped from fault vein and selected from dump which did not reveal any visible mineralization. The assay values were very low with only minor values for Ag and Pb.
