GEOLOGY: Workings are in shales and slates of the Palmetto Formation of Ordov-
ician age. The workings are crude hand dug gopher-holes along a N25°W vein that
dips erratically. Parts of the vein are strongly brecciated with green coatings
on some of the minerals. Sample 2061 was from the vein but the assays were with-
