DEVELOPMENT: A single old shaft and several prospect pits.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: The tree timbered old shaft sits atop a hill on a 3-4 foot iron-stained quartz vein. The last mile or so are without the benefit of a road. Locally deeply weathered shales and slates and occasional thin bedded limestones make up the host rocks. Sample 2062 was taken from the vein. Assay values were anomalous in As 700ppm, Cr. 150ppm, and Ni 70ppm.
