DEVELOPMENT: A series of small shafts, inclines and prospects line the sothern slope.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Narrow huebnerite bearing quartz veins were explored in exposed granite along an N-S trend that dips variously to the east. Much of the vein material showed post depositional movement. The veins range in width from a few inches to 2 feet. A ball mill on the south slope still has its footings but little else, nor did it operate for long as there is very little tailings. Sample 2068 from the exposed veins assayed high in tungsten 700ppm.
