ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Drilling done sometime in the recent pass.

GEOLOGY: The shaft and adjacent prospects are all in a densely welded tuff that is altered to a punky white west of the shaft. The rhyolite appears to have intruded the granites and Paleozoic sediments locally. Sample 2071 was taken from the dumps near the shaft. Assay values were Ag 1000ppm, Pb 1000ppm with lessor values for Antimony and zinc.
