With reference to the verbal agreement with you, Paul Reeve and Francis Fillerup in June for the construction of a pilot metallurgy plant at Manhattan, please note the list of items supplied and installed.

All material and equipment in the plant with the exception of the following is Summa's property.

2	50 yard steel ore bins approximate value \$3,000 each	\$6,000.00
1	15 x 15' tank and Galigher 4' agitator without motor approximate value \$6,000	6,000.00
2	25 Hp. electric motors (on crusher) approximate value \$500 each	1,000.00
1	Fine ore feeder approximate value \$100	100.00
1	12" x 10' sluice box without motor approximate value \$150	<u>150.00</u>
	Pruett Equipment	\$13,150.00

The \$4,000 advance paid by Summa on machinery and expenses is applied against the steel work for the ball mill and crushing units \$1,000.00

and \$3,000.00 against general expenses and assembly of the plant.

I have spent approximately 6 weeks, 6 days a week on this unit.

The Lease Agreements on Belmont and Manhattan prepared by Morse, Foley, and Wadsworth would be acceptable to Mineop Corporation with the following additions:

Page 4, paragraph 7: 20 shifts of 3 men.

Page 9, paragraph 22: Add paragraph of this meaning:

Lessor shall provide notice of intent to purchase equipment within 10 days of termination of this lease. If the option is not exercised within said 60 day requirement, the period allowed the Lessee to remove machinery shall be extended 60 days.
