LOCATION

Black Mountain Mining District, Mineral County, Nevada, about 25 miles southwest of Mina.

GEOLOGY

Narrow fissure vein varying in width from a few inches to about 2½ feet, occurring in a fine grain andesite flow. Vein filling is badly crushed, and it consists principally of replaced andesite and vein quartz carrying considerable iron oxide, with some silver and gold values, together with occasional lead carbonate and galena.

DEVELOPMENT

Development consists of a 25-foot incline shaft sunk at a point where a transverse fault displaces the fissure, an inaccessible 30-foot incline shaft and a small surface cut. No ore reserves.
