LOCATION

Black Mountain Mining District, Mineral County, Nevada, 16 miles southwest of Mina.

GEOLOGY

Two intersecting fissure veins enclosed in shaley limestone and quartzites, which are the extensions of the Shoemaker Extension and Moho veins which have had substantial production on the adjoining property.

On the Nevada Bellville property the veins range in widths up to about 4 feet, and the vein filling, as well as the walls, is badly broken and shattered. Mineralization consists of limonite, hematite, replaced quartzite and limestone, carrying minor amounts of gold and silver. Sampling indicates that the Moho vein has been mechanically enriched for a depth of a few feet.

DEVELOPMENT

The Moho vein is exposed on the surface in only a few places and has been developed by a 95-foot incline shaft, from which two short levels have been turned at the 60-foot and 95-foot horizons; a shallow 30-foot incline shaft; and two open cuts. The Shoemaker Extension vein has been only superficially prospected by one shallow open cut.
