NAME OF PROPERTY

Endowment Mine -

Mark G. Bradshaw - leaser

LOCATION OF PROPERTY

Marietta Mining District, Mineral County, Nevada, 29 miles SW of Mina, Nevada.

GEOLOGY

Siliceous sediments (strike N 60°-70° E, dip 50°-70° SE) ranging from argillite to conglomerate. Vein system exhibited small bodies of ore confined to intersections of vein and faults. Economic metals silver, lead, and zinc.

DESCRIPTION OF PROPERTY

Property consists of 3 lode claims. Principal workings consist of adit, incline shaft, and net-work of old drifts, cross-cuts, and stopes.

PRESENT AND POTENTIAL ORE RESERVES

Four foot width averaged 4.5 oz. Ag, 8.3% Pb, and 4.8% Zn. Tonnage estimate impossible.

Property operated as silver-lead mine until 1904.
