ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Just being staked by College kid workings for Goldfield, However, blasting to the south.

GEOLOGY: Northern facing ridge of McCoy site series of large open pits, with extensive trenching dredging and open pitting at sample site thinly bedded, highly altered bleached shales and quartzite (Cane Springs Fm?) dipping 45° south. Thin layer of fibrous green mineral (epidote) out cropping throughout workings. Area sheared and faulted with FeOx staining, massive gossan, some kaolinization. Minor pyrite.
