ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Staking on a large scale and very recent.

GEOLOGY: Area of several square miles on northend of Fish Creek Mtns. have been prospected along contacts between the volcanics and Paleozoic sediments of the Havallah Formation.

Photo 8 & 9. An inclined shaft on the eastside of the district.

Photo 10, is in silicified sediments of Havallah. The shaft was sunk on a oxidized bedding plane fault that strikes N 5° E and dips 60° SW. The dump and fracture zone was selectively sample #394. Mineralization included; ferrous garnet and oxidized copper. Several other pits to the east of the adit show simular copper oxides.
