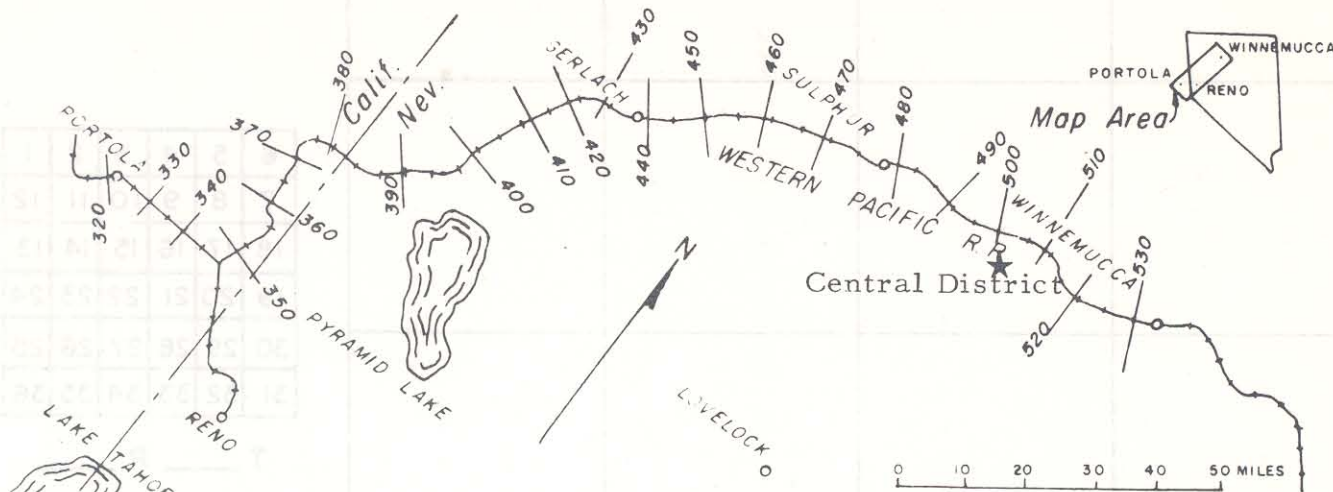

In 1869 a 2-stamp mill was erected on the Golden Age property and was operated for a short time. In 1872 a 4-stamp mill and a Stedefelt furnace were erected in this area, but this plant soon shut down because of litigation; it was destroyed by fire in 1876. Subsequently, small (over)

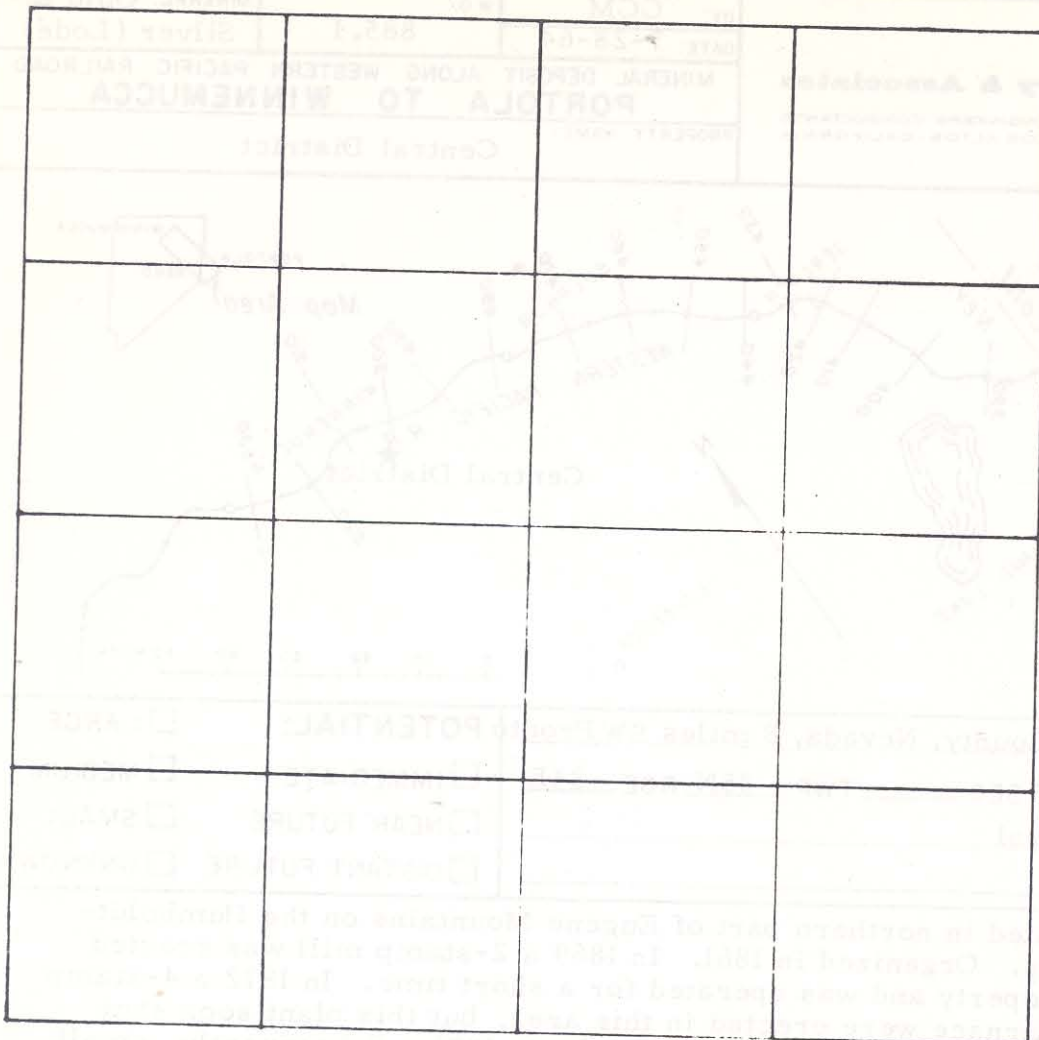

DESCRIPTION (continued) lots of ore were treated at the Wise reduction plant at Winnemucca and at the Clark Mill on the Humboldt River. Both of these plants were small and operated largely on custom ores. The production of precious metals from this district in the early days is not available, but in all probability the amount was not large. In recent years (1930-37) the district has been intermittently active; most of the activities being attributable to lessees who have made occasional carload shipments of ore to Utah smelters.
