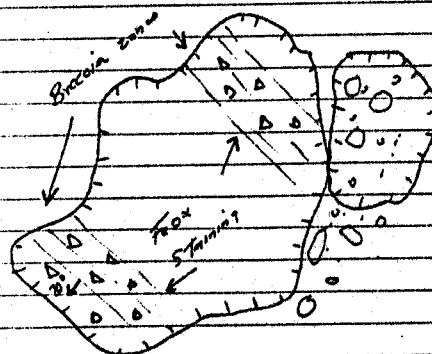

GEOLOGY: Workings explore bedrock contact between N70 E, 45 NW striking hornfels and overlying boulder-gravels, gravels drape over bedrock, contain highly stream-polished quartzite boulders up to 3' in diameter.

Old workings appear to have been mainly in the gravel, but some mining of bedrock was done. Cut in hornfels beneath gravel explores N40 W, 70 SW fracture zone, has 2"-6" thick bands of brecciated hornfels is cemented by white quartz and limonite, zone is about 3' wide.
