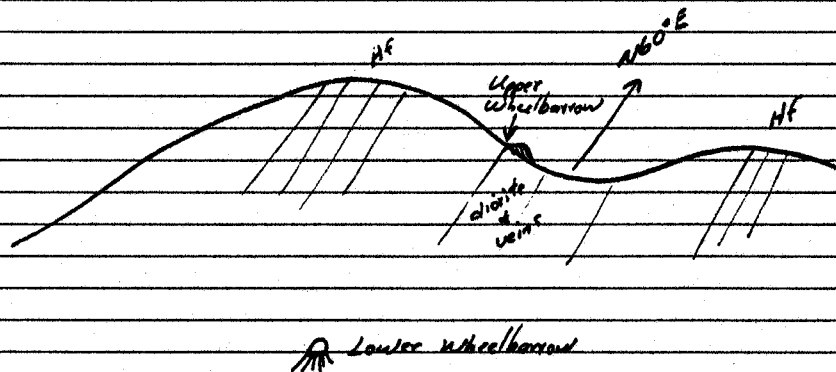

GEOLOGY: Old workings follow N60 E trend, project to northeast to connect with vein outcrops at upper Wheelbarrow. Diorite intrusive is exposed in portal of western adit, south of road, contact trends N60 E but cannot be seen east of the road or on the hill slope to the north. Dumps contain white quartz vein material, no sulfides seen here. Diorite must be a dike, must finger out to the north. Hornfels crops out both east and west of the vein zone, is silicated and forms bold outcrops in contrast to the weathered diorite.
