ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Adits follow N60 E, 55 NE quartz veins in green-tan, shaley hornfels, hornfels foliation N80 E, 45 NW, Quartz veins milky white, 2"-6" thick, FeOx staining, vein centers are vuggy with large quartz crystals in vugs. Largest dump has galena and sphalerite clots in vein fragments, near vein, wallrock is bleached and laced with FeOx.

REMARKS: Main workings are in the canyon to the southwest, these apparent workings are on the vein outcrops.
