DEVELOPMENT: Two adits, probably interconnected, one shaft.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: Thin band of silicated limestone, strike N60°E, 20°NW dip, intersected by N-S and N10°E, vertical, shear zone, Cuox & MnO along shears, and in bedding at shear intersections. Mineralized lenses along bedding up to 1 foot thick, most are thinner. Ore on dump consists of vuggy, cellular mass of epidote & pyrite (50% each), some garnet skarn.

Upper dump, from shaft, sunk on granodiorite contact, composed mostly of Cuox-stained skarn.
