1. The Laboratory makes free identifications and analyses of ORES, MINERALS, ROCKS, or FOSSILS only. This service is restricted to Nevada citizens, and to samples collected from within the boundaries of the State.
2. Do not send soil or water samples to this Laboratory. Send:
 SOIL samples to: Agricultural Soils Research Laboratory, University of Nevada, Reno, Nevada.
 WATER samples to: Nevada Health Department, Hygienic Laboratory, Reno, Nevada.
3. The major purpose of this service is to aid the prospector in the discovery of new mineral deposits. By law, this work may not be done for operating mines, or for engineers sampling mines or prospects for purposes of valuation, or for so-called "control assays" to check other assayers.
4. Number all samples. Do not grind or pulverize them. Samples weighing less than 5 ounces will not be assayed.
5. Two assays for gold or silver, five quantitative determinations or analyses of so-called strategic minerals, and ten identifications of ordinary rocks and minerals are allowed in any 30-day period.
6. If microscopic examinations or qualitative tests indicate that the sample is of no commercial value, an exact quantitative analysis will not be made.
7. After making the identification or analysis, the sample is kept for three months and then thrown away.
8. The report on the sample is mailed usually within 10 working days after receiving the sample and the required information.
