DEVELOPMENT: Shafts shown on map have been destroyed, possibly by milling of dumps, remains of leach pads, water tanks, several thousand feet underground workings.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, but entire area explored, surface and subsurface, within 1-3 years

GEOLOGY: Workings explore subsurface fault zones in Tertiary Pozo Formation which is overlain by Tertiary ash fall tuffs. Mineralization occurs as pyrite in white calcite cementing mudstone/phyllite breccia, abundant open spacing. Rocks heavily FeOx stained, and yellowish pyrite oxidization. Workings predominantly in alluvium, no structure apparent.
