DEVELOPMENT: Four inclines several shafts, two adits and half dozen prospects. Much more than is shown on the map

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Drilled within the last last five years, by Louisiana Land Co. They held the ground for 5-years and dropped it.

GEOLOGY: All of the workings are hosted in light gray, lithic rich, tuff that may be related to a ring-fracture zone of the Mount Jefferson caldera. They follow the strike of a fault zone that trends N10-15W and dip 55E. Several of the inclines have been sunk on the dip slope of the vein which varies in width within a 5-8 foot gouge zone. Sample 2083 was taken from the vein and dump adjacent to the northern most shaft. Sample 2084 was chipped from within the gouge zone and from dumps on and near the southern most shaft. Assays had moderate values in silver, arsenic, copper, antimony, molybdenum and lead. Mr. Berg reported his father mined these workings for gold?
