Name and Owner. GOOD LUCK GROUP. JOHN RUPERT, Owner.

Location and Holdings. (4 claims, located July 20, 1917, in
(Morey Mining District, about 95 miles North
(of Tonopah, near road to Eureka, via Hot Creek Valley.

Accessibility and Transportation. (Fair roads to 1/2 miles of property,
(Last 1/2 mile up steep hill

Geology. Country Rock is a medium grained granite rock, locally known as
Monzonite.

Veins or Ore Bodies. Silicified shear zone in "Monzonite". Strike
east and west, dip about 90 degrees, width 3 to 8 ft.
Shows through three claims. Occasional galena
in croppings, with low silver assays. A few tons
of lead silver ore shipped from small lens
at west end of property. No indications of
possible leaching.

Samples and Assays. None taken.

Developement. Several short shafts and tunnels. A little ore
opened in two or three widely scattered places
by the original locator, Mr. Williams. All showings
proved to be very small.

Present Equipment. None

Metallurgy.

Wood, Water and Power. Power line at Tybo, 25 miles south.
Wood and water can be easily obtained.

Price and Terms. \$3000.00 cash, balance of \$27,000.00 on long time,
plus 1/7 of stock in company.

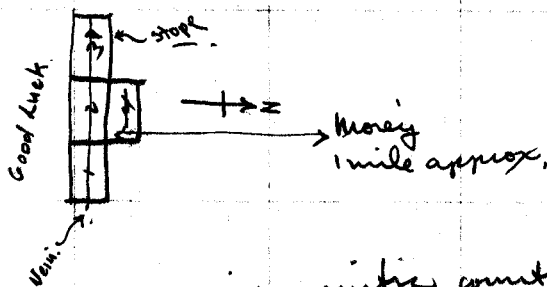

Medium grained, granitic country - called locally
 monzonite. - striking N+S, dip 65° E

Shear zone, silicified, a little Mn. stain on
 fractures, E+W, dip 90°. A little galena on
 cropping. - vein 4'-8' wide, banded thin
 three clams.

One stone only seen - next and small
 1 1/2" - 2 1/2' wide, 25' high, 20' long, - from specimen
 ore was iron stained with galena partially altered
 to carbonate.
