Night before last I had a call from Mr. Norman S. Feister, of Sparks, Nevada. Discussed in some detail was his interest in molybdenum in the Mountain City area of this state, his relationship with the owners of the property, and plans to proceed with the prospect's exploration and development, under Arrelle Mining Company, which he is now organizing.
