

Lincoln Claim - Pb

From point on Alt. U. S. 95, midway between the Shurz Jct. and the Schurz cut-off, turn SW. through wire gate and travel 1.9 miles stopping in heavy sand. Walk about 3/4 mile up canyon, which is on left, to tie cabin. The lower adit here is all in metamorphosed shales about 100' SW. of a diorite contact. No apparent reason for this adit.

Above this is an adit with 200' of workings showing two galena bunches on interbed shears. A winze has been sunk on each showing.

Above this is what is known as tunnel #3. A small stope of Pb ore has been mined above this level and adjacent to the diorite contact, which is exposed in the drift near the stope. The contact is parallel to the bedding, NW. strike with dip 35° NE. A winze has also been sunk here. Ore in this area contains calcite, quartz, garnet, epidote, galena and zinc. Although having a width of 2' to 3', it is usually spotty.

Above this adit a trail leads to a little "scabbing" which exposed 8" to 12" of Pb ore of apparent short length in interbed occurrence. Above this on hillside a 12' hole exposed a fair but spotty showing of Pb-Zn which may be in the same bed or slightly in the footwall of lower exposure.

These latter 2 spots are the best places to prospect as was recommended to Bill Dial, who accompanied me to property.

Same owners also have a Sunset claim about 1/2 mile south of where cars were parked. Did not look at this, but mineralization is said to be similar to Lincoln.
