This property owned by Mr. Rushworth and others, of Schurz, was brought to our attention by Messrs. Hamlin and O'Brien.

It was examined and sampled on October 6th, the samples being assayed at our laboratory established at Summerfield camp east of Mina.

This property, which is about four miles west of Schurz and approximately 1500 feet higher, contains a deposit of tungsten-bearing epidote on the contact between a wide spread diorite and local granitic intrusions. The appearance in out crop is of a roughly eval "blow out" approximately 100 feet in longer dimension by 70 or 80 feet in shorter dimension.

Six samples were cut from this deposit. Four of them were continuous 5-foot cuts across a 20-foot open cut on the south side of the deposit and assayed .19, .51, .27 and .22% WO3. Approximately 20 feet north of this trench another open cut exposed an additional 10 feet in which two continuous 5-foot cuts were taken. These assayed .16 and .26% WO3.

Although higher grade specimens have been produced on this property, this sampling indicates that it is in general very low and not of interest as a commercial deposit.
