DEVELOPMENT: Drill road, pad, rotary drill hole

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, nearby road building and drilling in recent years

GEOLOGY: Road cut exposes a series of N75°E-bearing quartz veins and aplite dikes that cut granite and felsite, wall rock sericitized, displays red hematite staining. Composite sample collected from several veins assayed 20 ppm silver, 200 ppm bismuth, and minor amounts of copper and molybdenite.

REMARKS: Phelps Dodge Corp. drill hole LP-6 drilled from pad, hole depth 690 feet, collared in "greisen", penetrated biotite granite, andesite, ended in schist. Hole averaged 21 ppm Mo, highest value about 95 ppm Mo.
