GEOLOGY: A 6-to 8-foot wide vein forms a bold outcrop on the east side of a tributary
canyon that feeds in from the north of Eleven Mile Canyon. The vein is hosted in andesite
and bears N60 W, dips 85 SW. The larger portion of the vein is a hydrothermal breccia
containing minor pyrite in highly silicified matrix. Assays ran at or below detection limits
for all elements except lead which ran 100 ppm.
