DEVELOPMENT: Timbered shaft with tripod headframe, three prospect pits

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: The workings explore narrow quartz veins occupying shear zones cutting andesite. The vein at the shaft is 12 inches wide, bears N65 E, and has an irregular dip. It is vuggy, vugs and fracture surfaces are coated with limonite and dark, red iron oxide, wall rocks are kaolinized on the vein contacts. Sample 3935, taken from the shaft dump, assayed 6.7 ppm gold (0.2 oz/ton) and 70 ppm silver. Sample 3936, taken from a small prospect east of the shaft, was collected from a N80 W, 70 E-dipping, highly brecciated vein. This sample contained 0.2 ppm gold. Sample 3937 was collected a few hundred feet to the northwest along the same vein as 3936; the sample was taken from a 6 inch wide vein exposure and consisted of fault breccia cemented with clear quartz, coated with iron oxides. This sample contained no gold. Sample 3938 was taken from a small prospect located south of the shaft area where narrow N-S trending quartz vein cut andesite, fine-grained black sulfides were seen in the vein material.
