ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None, nearby road building and drilling in recent years

GEOLOGY: Adit was driven in felsite near a granite contact, granite crops out a few hundred feet to the south. The adit bears N55° E but is caved at the portal. Sample 3931 collected from the dump contained copper oxides and sulfides, possibly galena. Assay ran 10 ppm silver, 200 ppm copper, 100 ppm lead.
