DEVELOPMENT: InclineACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Incline was sunk on a 2-foot wide banded quartz vein that may be a projection of the vein sampled in sample 3944. The vein cuts granite and strikes N70° E, granite is kaolinized sericitized. The vein contains copper oxide minerals and silver sulfides. Sample 3945 assayed 700 ppm silver, 700 ppm bismuth, 700 ppm lead, 1500 ppm antimony, 500 ppm zinc, and 0.05 ppm gold.

REMARKS: This area is within claims formerly held and explored by Freeport Exploration and later Phelps Dodge Corporation, activity consisted of road building, geochemical sampling, and some rotary drilling.
