Vanderburg 1936

Muttleberry District

At south end of Humboldt Range, 9 miles by road and a little south of east of Lovelock. Principal property is old TIGER MINE which shipped some silver-lead-antimony ore in 1910. 40 cars of ore is total production. Mill built in 1919, but soon abandoned.

Formation is slate, limestone and quartzite, capped in places by Tertiary volcanics. All development confined to north side of a small ravine tributary to Muttleberry Canyon. About 1000 feet of development from five closely spaced tunnels.

Ore occurs in a flat, irregular vein in limestone. Values in silver and lead with a little gold. Antimony and a little copper present.

Gypsum deposits, extensive, in the area but not described in these notes.
