DEVELOPMENT: One 4-5' deep prospect, partially filled in with rock & debris. One drill road with one drill hole adjacent to prospect & extending 20' to W.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None. Drill roads look at least 10 years old.

GEOLOGY: Working explores med-bedded, silicified, calcite veined limestone (probably Devonian Age). The bedding strikes E-W & dips $\approx 50^\circ$ to N in area of prospect. The limestone is Fe-stained & brecciated possibly along fractures. Not much structure was observed, but breccia & slicks on dump indicate the rock is faulted.

The drill road & drill hole are in same limestone unit. Limestone cuttings were noted by drill hole.

REMARKS: Sample 711 - Silicified limestone fine limestone breccia.
