In good shape. No equipment around. Track in adit.6) An explosives storage area lies on so.-side of canyon, across from tin sheds Heavy locked Iron door & front to storage area.7) Did not see shaft. Looks like area where shaft is supposed to be has been dozed in.8) Picture #2 on camera on so. side of canyon on old shaft dump(?) Looking No. at open workings, Shed & structures along which adit is driven.9) Looks like old dump have been partially mined & treated somewhere. Lots of dozer work has been done around old workings.10) Did not see the Hi "oh" Mine.
