DEVELOPMENT: Single, vertical shaft, with probably 500 feet underground workings

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Workings collared in alluvium, no structure observed. Dump composed of mafic rich augen gneiss (PG) which is brecciated and cut by quartz veins. The rocks are coated with FeOx. The breccia is cemented by cockscomb quartz and carries oxidized sulfides. The site appears to be more of an exploratory shaft than a serious producer. There are randomly placed dumps and prospect pits throughout the west facing slope of the Spirit Mountain.
