DEVELOPMENT: Two shafts, cuts, trenches.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None.

GEOLOGY: White quartz vein strike N80°E, 70°NW Dip, in sheared, coarse-grained granite, vein stained red from hematite, some MnO present. Central vein 5'-6' thick with thinner stringers in each wall. Vein appears to pinch out to a hematite-coated fracture to the west, vein quartz extends to east for 600' to 1000'. Vein appears to have been cut by faulting, pods of vein quartz seen completely surrounded by granite. Granite in walls of vein appears to have been slightly chloritized.

Several cuts prospect the vein, and two deep shafts are still open (about 1000' apart along strike). Remains of a small mill and camp are visible west of the western-most shaft (shown on the topo sheet).
