DEVELOPMENT: Inclined shaft, with minor peripheral trenches and cuts,

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Shaft follows a Nw striking, NE70° dipping shear zone, 1 to 5 feet wide, with quartz cementing the shear material. Abundant open spacing filled with euhedral quartz crystals, and coated with psilomeline. Minute sulfides are disseminated through the quartz, with pods and stringers of calcite. A silvery, flaky minerals occurs in stringers and along fractures. Along the shear material, appear brecciated pieces of argillically altered intrusive (possibly parts of the dike system mentioned at sample site 1333). The silicious and mafic dikes mentioned at 1333 appear to continue north to this site. Host rock granitic gneiss with plagioclase "eyes" in augen texture, ranging up to 2 inches.. Abundant Fe-Mn staining, rocks highly fractures. Amount of quartz veins decreases with altitude. 2-20 foot mafic dike prominent at site.
