ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: None

GEOLOGY: Quartz veins in granite, eastern adit shows two parallel veins, one 12" thick, one 6", separated by 24" sheared granite. Veins shattered, FeOx-stained, green & blue CuOx, white quartz with clots chalcopryrite rimmed with chalcopryrite, meloconite. Veins strike N05° W, are near-vertical. Shaft sunk on N05°-10°W, vert. to 70°NE dipping shear zone in granite, zone 5'-6' wide at shaft collar, vein material on dump white quartz with Cu minerals, bands of FeOx stained black tourmaline with quartz.
