DEVELOPMENT: None, however, road that runds down W. face of range being graded that same day.

ACTIVITY AT TIME OF EXAMINATION: Drill holes within last 5 years trailer parked down ridge from workings

GEOLOGY: Southern site consists of at least 10 vertical shafts, adits and dog holes along a line trending generally N10W. Small spring in stope. Considerably more prospects than shown on map. Several shafts inclinded N55E, Almost vertical following dip of fault, N10W. Other faulting N20E, N55E, Minor. Country rock principally light to medium grey ash flow tuff with lithic fragments up to 1 cm, quartz crystals 1-5mm. Feox stained, Mg-Mn staining drusy quartz filling vugs and fractures. There was no apparent mineralization. Some of outcrops bleached white, some of ash flow tuff brecciated and cemented with drusy quartz. The northern workings consists of 2 shafts (vertical?) with old timbers and partially caved, along same N10W trending, slicks, Fe-Mg-Mn staining, drusy and chalcedony.
