REPORT ON NORTHUMBERLAND MINE BY J. C. PERKINS, MANAGER

Dec. 21, 1946

The Northumberland Mine is located in the Northumberland Mining District in central northern Nye County, Nevada. The mine is on the easterly crest of the Tequima range of mountains and at an elevation of approximately 8500 feet. The topography is rolling. Tonopah, the nearest point of supply, is reached by a good desert road 78 miles in length. At present, Mina, Nevada is the closest rail connection.

The Northumberland Mining District was organized back in the late "Sixties" after silver bearing ores were discovered there by early day prospectors. The production of silver was confined to the last century and was sporadic and amounted to approximately \$37,000.00

Gold bearing ores were discovered at Northumberland late in 1936. The present owners of the property, Mr. Haggerty and associates, acquired the property early in 1938 and during that year carried on a comprehensive development program. The result of this work was to fully develop 187,500 tons of \$6.20 gold ore and to indicate that more ore would probably be found.

The Northumberland Mining Company was organized during the year 1939, the mining and milling equipment of the 300 ton cyanide plant of the Weepah Nevada Mining Company at Weepah was acquired and moved to Northumberland, where along with other additions including a 675 h.p. Diesel Electric plant, was erected and put into operation in November of that year.

Mining was done by conventional open pit methods and as
